1. What to do before the track

You will be notified at the teach inn of the event at what time you should arrive on the track for the official technical inspections and registration. Please make sure you arrive on time since there is not a lot of time to spare.

Things to organize as a race participant / team before the track:

- Get organized; make sure your “team” is aware of all necessary rules / guides that will apply at the event.
- Appoint various team members for their specific jobs.
- Get your toolbox ready and make sure it has a lock, nobody then you only will be responsible for loss of any tools, personal items or parts at the tracks.
- Do not get to many persons involved in your crew since this will only crowd up your pit area which can cause frustration during the race.
- Make up a check list for all the things you will need. You already have so much to worry about.

2. Who to bring to the track

- Appoint the right person for the right job.
- If possible supply all personnel with identifiable gear. E.g. shirts with your race team logo. This is a good opportunity to expose your team and eventual sponsors.
- Do not bring persons that are / will be under influence of any substance that may cause drowsiness. Do not use alcohol at all times during this time.

Remember: your safety is also in there hands.

3. Arriving at the tracks

- When you have arrived at the tracks you will need to follow instructions from the track officials, these will guide you to the inspection lane.
- After the inspection has taken place you will be assigned to you pit area.
- Set up your pit area in a way that you will not cause any disturbance to you neighboring racer. He is your friendly neighbor but also your opponent.
- Please keep in mind that this will not be you permanent pit area.
- Please keep you area clean at all times.



4. What should you bring?

- You can bring all the essentials that may help you through the race but keep in mind that you will only have a limited space available in your pit area.
- Cold drinks will be sold at the tracks but you can bring your ice box to help keep you hydrated during the whole day. For racing participants, drinks will be sold on the initial buy at a reduced price on site.
- Since selling food and beverages will be the only income for the organization we encourage all attendees to purchase their food and beverages at the track.

5. Positive attitude

- Since there will be great exposure of this event towards local authorities we encourage a positive sportsman's attitude.
- Only with the help of all motor sport enthusiasts we can get this sport at a higher recognizable level.

Please keep it safe and take it from the streets to the track!
